

3. Garter Stitch Four Point Hat

STITCH USED - Garter stitch

MEASUREMENTS -

		Lady	Man
Fits head (approx)	cm	56	59

YARN REQUIRED -

PATONS INCA 50g balls	3	4
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NEEDLES AND EXTRAS -

- 1 pair 7.00mm (No 2) Knitting Needles or size needed to give correct tension.
- A Wool Needle for sewing up.

TENSION -

12.5 sts and 23 rows to 10 cm over garter st, using 7.00mm Needles (see page 8).

ABBREVIATIONS -

st, sts = stitch, stitches
beg = beginning

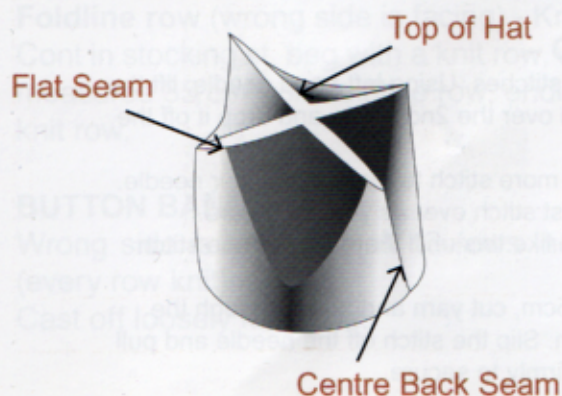
cm = centimetres
mm = millimetres

SEWING HAT TOGETHER

INSTRUCTIONS

Using 7.00mm Needles, cast on 61 (65) sts.

1st row (wrong side is facing and beginning of yarn is at the left side) - Knit.

Knit in garter st (every row knit) until hat measures 29 (32) cm from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

With right side facing, cast off loosely knitways.

MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Using wool needle and running stitch seam (see page 12), join side edges together for centre back seam, noting to reverse the seam for 8 (9) cm on lower edge for turn back of brim (see diagram A). Fold back brim onto right side as pictured. Fold top of hat into a star shape (see diagram B). Using a flat seam (see page 12), sew top of hat. Sew in all ends.
